- L'Anse aux Meadows** A UNESCO World Heritage Site & only authenticated European (Norse) settlement in North America. Try blacksmithing, woodworking, weaving, or The Test of Tykir Escape Room. ## Hiking & Walking

- Indian Lookout Trail** 3-4 day backcountry hike that summits 640m for panoramic coastal views. 40 km. Portland Creek. [iatn.org](http://iatn.org)
- John Hogan Trail** Meander the Torrent River, Hawke's Bay. 3 km boardwalk. Easy
- Marjorie Bridge & Thrombolites Walking Trail** Fossil record of the earth's most primitive life forms. Flower's Cove. Easy. [townofflowerscove.com](http://townofflowerscove.com)
- Northeast Way:**
  - Barr'd Island Trail** Coastal views of the quaint fishing community, Englee. 0.5 km loop.
  - Glass Hole Trail** Geology, history, & coastal lookouts. Conche. 6.8 km return.
  - Underground Salmon Pool** Only place in the world where salmon travel underground to complete their migration. Route 433. 1.9 km loop.
- River of Ponds Walking Trail** Nature along one of Newfoundland's best salmon rivers. River of Ponds. 3km.
- St. Anthony Trails: Bottom Brook** An easy, lit 1 km scenic nature trail. Seating area along the way.
- Fishing Point Municipal Park** Trailhead for 4 trails with exhilarant ocean views, icebergs & whales.
- Lamage Point Trail** Beautiful view of cliffs, ocean, icebergs, and whales. St. Anthony. [stanthony.ca](http://stanthony.ca)
- Wanderer's Peak Tall Tale Trail** A short story trail with spectacular views. Parson's Pond; Moderate. 5.1km loop.
