Work with other local food & beverage operators to replace single-use plastics with backyard compostable take-out containers. I.e., Order take-out containers in bulk to reduce the impacts of shipping emissions.

Collaborate with other businesses and local municipalities to create a regional composting program.

Local businesses and accommodations can work with organizations like Atlantic Healthy Oceans Initiative (AHOI) to create a more circular business model and step away from single use plastics, enabling a more sustainable, eco-friendly offer to their guests.
